Individual Lemma



The dictionary interface provides a help function for the citation of individual lemmata. The default scheme is:¹

[Author(s)] ([Year]): [Lemma]. eDiAna [Version].

Busse, Anja & Opfermann, Andreas & Sasseville, David (2017): *sóru-. eDiAna (2017.1).

In-text citation



Within the dictionary, every lemma has a stable identification number, which is ideal for short in-text citation:

[Author(s)] ([Year]): eDiAna ID [Identification Number].

E.g.

Busse, Opfermann & Sasseville 2017: eDiAna ID 219

Individual Lemma Chapter



As each dictionary entry called up is assembled on the fly, stable page numbers or URLs cannot be provided. Therefore the smallest referential unit is the chapter / subchapter:

[Author(s)] ([Year]): [Chapter], [Subchapter]. In: eDiAna s.v. [Lemma]. eDiAna [Version].
